### **1. Internship in the Green Group in the European Parliament.**

It concerns a full-time internship for a period of **6 months**, starting from the **1st of September 2008**.

#### **Job content:**

The exact issues you would be working on are open for discussion between the secretariat of the Green Group, yourself and FYEG on the basis of our and your personal needs. However, you will certainly be involved in the Climate Change Campaign and the European Election Campaign run by FYEG.

#### **Candidate profile:**

- has good knowledge of the English language, both orally and in writing,
- is younger than 30 years,
- is registered as a student,
- is able to work independently and shows initiative.
- Has at least basic computer skills

Knowledge of other European languages is a plus.

The intern will receive a monthly allowance of € 500,- plus a housing grant of € 250,- per month. Also included is a limited health and accident insurance.

## **2. Internship in FYEG Headquarters in Brussels.**

It concerns a full-time internship for a period of **4 months**, starting from the **1<sup>st</sup> of September 2008** and ending the **19<sup>th</sup> of December 2008**.

We always discuss thoroughly with our interns how they and we get most out of their time within FYEG. Your personal or educational needs and wishes are the basis of our co-operation.

The position is unpaid. FYEG will only reimburse local travel costs and lunch costs (within a limited budget).

### **Job content:**

- Assist in the daily work of the Secretary General of FYEG.
- Make reports of meetings or activities, in order to facilitate the work of the Executive Committee and Secretary General
- Survey on FYEG Activities and involvement of its member organisations
- Help and involvement of the European Election Campaign (design of materials and of the website)
- Communications are a big part of the internship tasks: website, newsletters etc. Therefore, basic graphic design skills and experience with website management are required

### **Candidate profile:**

- A good knowledge of the English language (written and oral) is necessary.
- Graphic design skills and knowledge of website design and management
- Knowledge of other European languages would be a plus.
- Younger than 30 year.
- Good writing and computer skills.
- Able to work independently and showing initiative.
