It does not represent an official standpoint of the organisation, but works as a channel to raise discussion and share ideas.

We are looking for three persons who have the courage to bring forward new ideas and explore the political field of the Greens in an unprejudiced way.

These three young greens together with one member of the Executive Committee compose the Editorial Board and therefore be responsible for the content of the Ecosprinter and for ensuring a high quality of the magazine as a whole.

The mission of the Ecosprinter is to:

- provide a forum for commentary and internal debate
- provide the spaces for blogs and articles of members of FYEG
- inform about the politics of EGP
- report and comment about culture, politics and discussions they believe are of importance.

The Ecosprinter editorial board:

- Consist of four members of which only one may be an EC member
- has to be gender-balanced
- follow democratic principles
- edit language deficiencies
- work on the mission and development of the Ecosprinter

Profile of candidate:

- A good knowledge of the English language (written and oral) is necessary
- Experience with the communications or publications of an organization in preferred
- Preferably younger than 30 years
- Good writing and computer skills
- Good lay-out skills
- Able to work independently and showing initiative
